13.01.2021- Guest Lecture Program (Total Number of Participants more than 100)

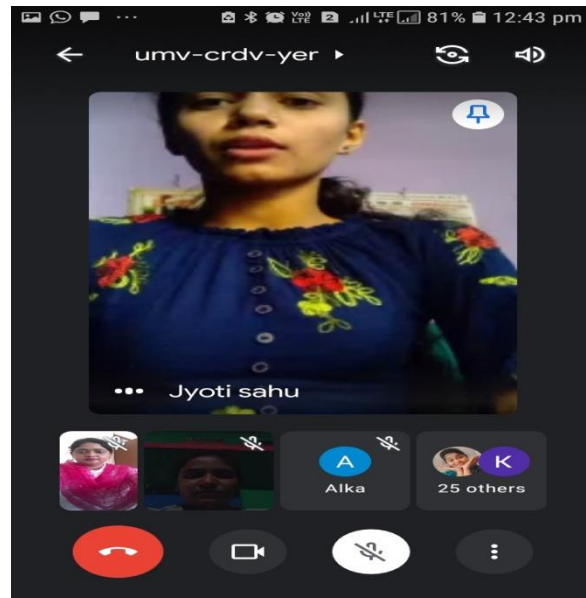
